

vBound Help – Microsoft Office 64-Bit

Issue

vBound will not work on a system that has the 64-bit version of Office installed.

To Determine Microsoft Office Version

Select File – Help from the ribbon of any of your Microsoft Office applications. The version information will include the 32-bit or 64-bit indicator.



Cause

This issue is due to incompatibilities between the 32-bit and 64-bit versions of Microsoft Office. For more information on this, please use the links below.

Resolution

vBound installs and uses the 32-bit version of the Microsoft Access 2010 runtime. You are not required to have any Microsoft Office products to use vBound, but if you do, the 32-bit version must be installed for compatibility.

To use vBound, you will need to uninstall the 64-bit version of Office and install the 32-bit version

From Microsoft: The 32-bit version of Office 2010 is the recommended option for most people, because it prevents potential compatibility issues with other 32-bit applications, specifically third-party add-ins that are available only for 32-bit operating systems.
